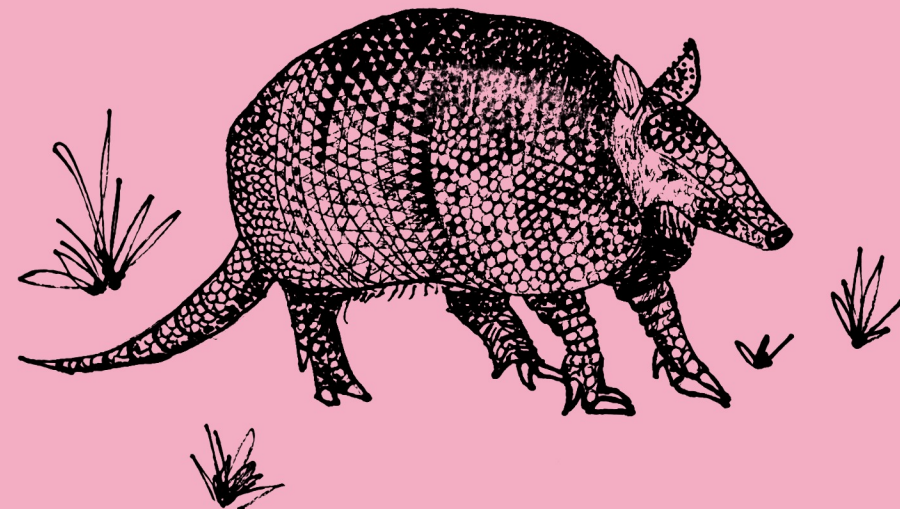

Mangroves

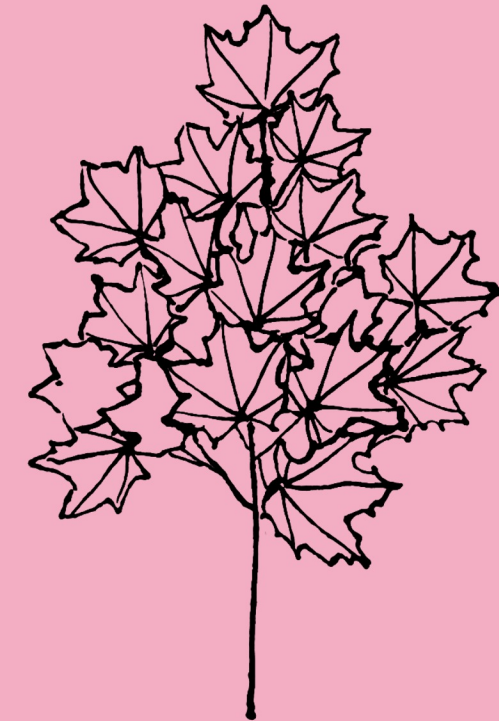
are
